# 01 Participation in Society and Housing

Housing is a human right. Volt is committed to more affordable housing and participation in society. Our goals at a glance:

- Funding of public and non-profit housing projects
- Hire-purchase models for small and medium incomes
- Mixed neighbourhoods with fair housing allocation
- Establishment of a regional housing association under the RVR
- Supporting alternative forms of housing such as multigenerational projects, home swaps and "housing for help"

PLUS: Strengthening public infrastructure - with drinking water fountains, accessible toilets and muted waste-collection systems

# 02 Education, Science and Diversity

Volt wants to enable equitable educational chances and lived diversity in the Ruhr region. Our goals at a glance:

- Establishment of an education monitoring and a masterplan for school reconstruction
- Setup of children's and youth bureaus to foster the participation of young people
- Programmes against discrimination, anti-semitism and queer hostility
- Funding of cultural and educational projects with schools and artists
- Connecting universities, research and civil society

PLUS: Foundation of a "Ruhr Inclusion Council" for and accessible and inclusive Ruhr region

# 03 Sustainable Mobility and Transport Transition

Volt is shaping the future of mobility - sustainable, connected and just. Our goals at a glance:

- Unified transport network with digital ticketing
- Extension of bus and rail service throughout the whole region
- Fast cycle routes and safe cycling infrastructure
- Micro-depots and e-cargo bikes for environmentally friendly delivery transport
- Options for accessible mobility for all generations

PLUS: A unified "Ruhr Integration and Participation Ticket" allows people with severe disabilities to travel at reduced rates throughout the whole Ruhr region.

# 04 Digitalisation and Innovation in Administration

Volt is making administration in the Ruhr region digital, open and user-friendly. Our goals at a glance:

- Joint digital strategy under the umbrella of the RVR
- Development of digital platforms for citizen's service and participation
- Utilisation of open source solutions ('public code')
- Artificial intelligence in administration utilised responsibly
- Funding of Open Data for more transparency and innovation

PLUS: The ruhr.apps offer access to mobility, culture, environment and service on a single platform.

# 05 Climate, Environment and Quality of Life

Volt transforms the Ruhr region to become climate-resilient and worth living in. Our goals at a glance:

- Greening roofs and facades, converting brownfields
- Funding of urban gardening and wildflower meadows
- Extension of drinking water fountains, accessible toilets and waste-collection systems
- Protection of urban forests, unsealing and new green spaces
- Regional heat protection plans and early warning systems

Best practice: underground waste-collection systems based on suction following the example of Helsinki - for clean cities

## 06 Economic Transformation and Innovation

Volt promotes a sustainable and digital economy in the Ruhr region.

Our goals at a glance:

- GStart-up centres for green tech, hydrogen and digitalisation
- Re-activation of industrial areas for innovation and co-working
- Promotion of regional supply chains with the help of the 'Made in Ruhr' label
- Assistance for small companies with digital transformation
- Equitable labour, advanced training and tariff commitment in new sectors

PLUS: Regional innovation clusters link universities, start-ups and municipalities

## 07 Shaping European Cooperation

Volt brings Europe to the cities of the Ruhr region. Our goals at a glance:

- Extension and strategic utilisation of city partnerships
- Europe Day with exchange formats and partner cities
- Introduction of a 'European Ruhr Pass' for youth mobility
- Better visibility and utilisation of EU funding

PLUS: EUROCITIES, RGRE and EUREGIO as useful platforms for municipal learning

## 08 Culture, Tourism and Identity

Volt strengthens the culture and diversity of the Ruhr region. Our goals at a glance:

- Equitable and inclusive funding for culture including migrant initiatives
- Promotion of sustainable concepts for tourism
- Support of cross-city mega events
- Visualisation of the culture of remembrance in public spaces

PLUS: Introduction of a tourism dashboard for data-based management of regional offerings

# 09 Youth, Participation and Democracy

Volt makes sure that youth participation is binding and powerful. Our goals at a glance:

- Lowering the voting age to 14 for municipal participation formats
- Establishment of youth parliaments and bureaus
- Digital participation budgets for young people
- Political education and protection of democratic spaces

PLUS: Shaping participation process in cooperation with adolescents - starting from planning going all the way to implementation.

# 10 Regional Development and Governance in the RVR

Volt strengthens the role of the RVR for the entire region. Our goals at a glance:

- More transparency, participation and digital access to the Ruhr Parliament
- Clear distribution of funding and competences within the RVR
- Monitoring systems for climate targets, mobility and social justice
- Inter-municipal cooperation on digitalisation and infrastructure

PLUS: Citizen-controlled funding and digital platforms as new forms of participation in society for a transparent regional development.

# 11 Emergency Management - Crisis-proof and Interconnected for Greater Resilience

Volt caters for a connected, modern civil protection in the region. Our goals at a glance:

- Establishment of a regional resilience network and centralised training and cooperation centers for civil protection
- Accessible early warning systems and coordinated emergency plans
- Protection of the IT infrastructure throughout the entire Ruhr region

Best practice: The rescEU programme serves as a model for European cooperation in civil protection.

### **About Volt**

Only a Europe that acts together can solve our shared challenges. National parties are reaching their limits. To counteract populist promises and give a home to all Europeans, we created Volt: the first pan-European party. We strive to empower people to change politics and unlock Europe's potential. Active in already more than 30 countries, we encourage citizens to rethink and shape politics in their cities, in their countries and across borders in Europe.

We are pan-European, pragmatic and progressive. While striving to promote diversity, we come together because of our shared goals and values. We ask the necessary questions and make realistic proposals to solve pan-European challenges.

#### Our plan for a better Europe

We work towards a united, federal Europe where everyone has equal chances to fulfil their unique potential. By uniting our strengths democratically, we strive to form a strong, responsible and transparent European government that acts in the interest of all Europeans.

Volt competed in the European Elections in 2019 for the first time and we led a cross-border election campaign with a European election programme. As a result, Damian Boeselager became the first Volter in the European Parliament. And the 2024 European Elections five Volt members were elected to the European Parliament.

### Volt Ruhr - Europe at the heart of the region

Volt Ruhr is the regional association of all Volt teams in the area of the Ruhr Regional Association (RVR) - with over 550 active members and supporters (as of July 2025) and growing. As a point of contact and coordination centre, Volt Ruhr strengthens local networking and cooperation in one of the most dynamic regions in Germany.

Volt is already represented in several German cities since the 2020 local elections. A milestone was the founding of the "Volt and Diversity" parliamentary group in Dortmund in January 2025 - together with the Alliance for Diversity and Tolerance (BVT). In doing so, we are taking a stand for a progressive, pro-European local policy in the region.

Our aspiration is to locally implement the experiences and solutions other European cities and regions made to our challenges - for a socially just, future-oriented Ruhr metropolitan region.
